Purpose of this CWG

Members of the Community Working Group have three primary responsibilities:

1. **Build knowledge** about middle school in DCPS and share updates with your community.
2. **Collect feedback** from members of the community you represent.
3. **Provide insight back to the CWG** based on the priorities of prospective students, family members, and community members you represent.

CWG Responsibilities for SY 2025-2026

- Attend all meetings of the CWG, typically held virtually.
- Distribute content from meetings to respective communities.
- Collect feedback from respective communities. In SY25-26, we'll ask you to focus feedback efforts "schematic designs" of the modernized building.
 - **By November 12, develop a plan** to (1) distribute content about schematic designs to respective communities and (2) collect feedback to share at the January 21, 2026, meeting.
 - **Between the January 7 and January 21 meetings, distribute content and collect feedback on schematic design options.**

Objectives of this meeting

By the end of this meeting, members will gain...

- An **understanding of the project scope** and timeline of the modernization.
- Insight into **Schematic Design** from the design-build team.
- An **opportunity to ask questions** about the modernization, discuss the **schematics designs of the building**, and plan for how to **gather feedback** from community members.

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What is the Project Scope ?

DCPS intends to renovate the new middle school campus to meet the school's programmatic needs, DCPS Education Specification (Ed Spec), and the projected enrollment. This modernization project will retain the existing ***historic building structure*** and maximizes the value of the courtyards. The scope will involve strategic placement of Ed Spec required spaces, upgrade of required finishes and systems to meet Ed Spec and NetZero goals.

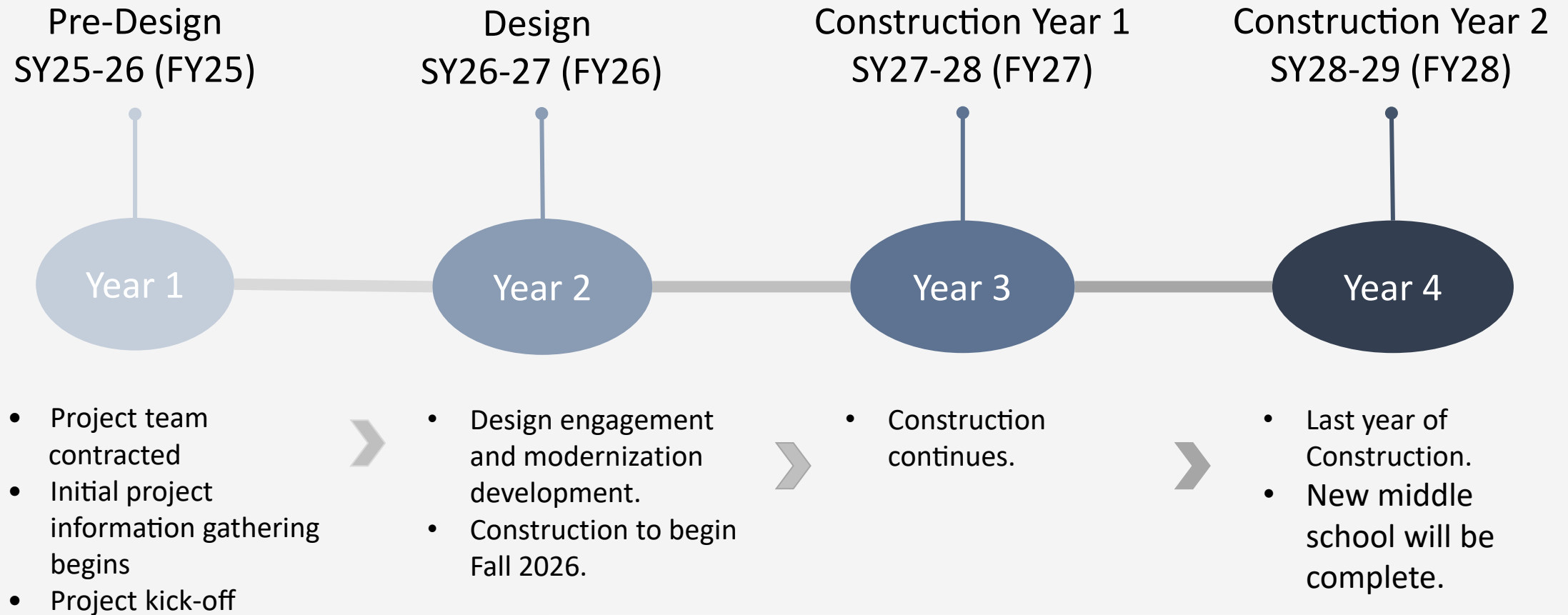

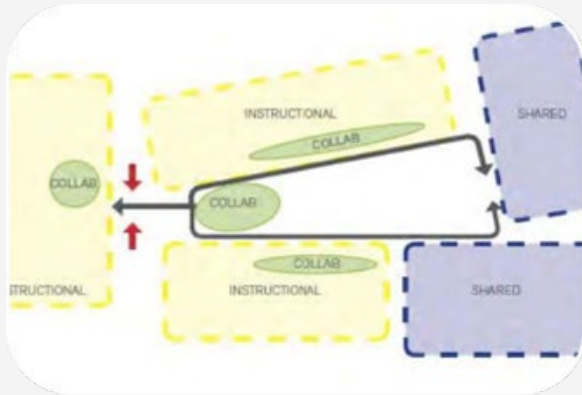
Project Timeline

Design Process

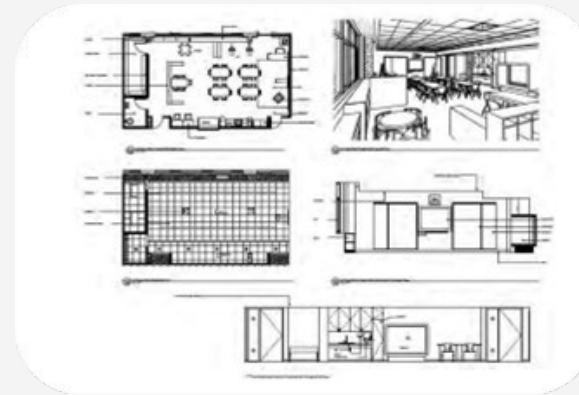
Each modernization follows a developmental sequence that is divided in four phases. Each phase builds off the last, with the engagement and input provided mainly in Concepts and Schematics.



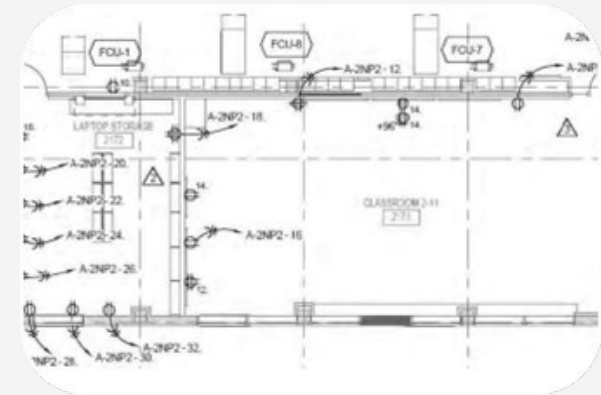

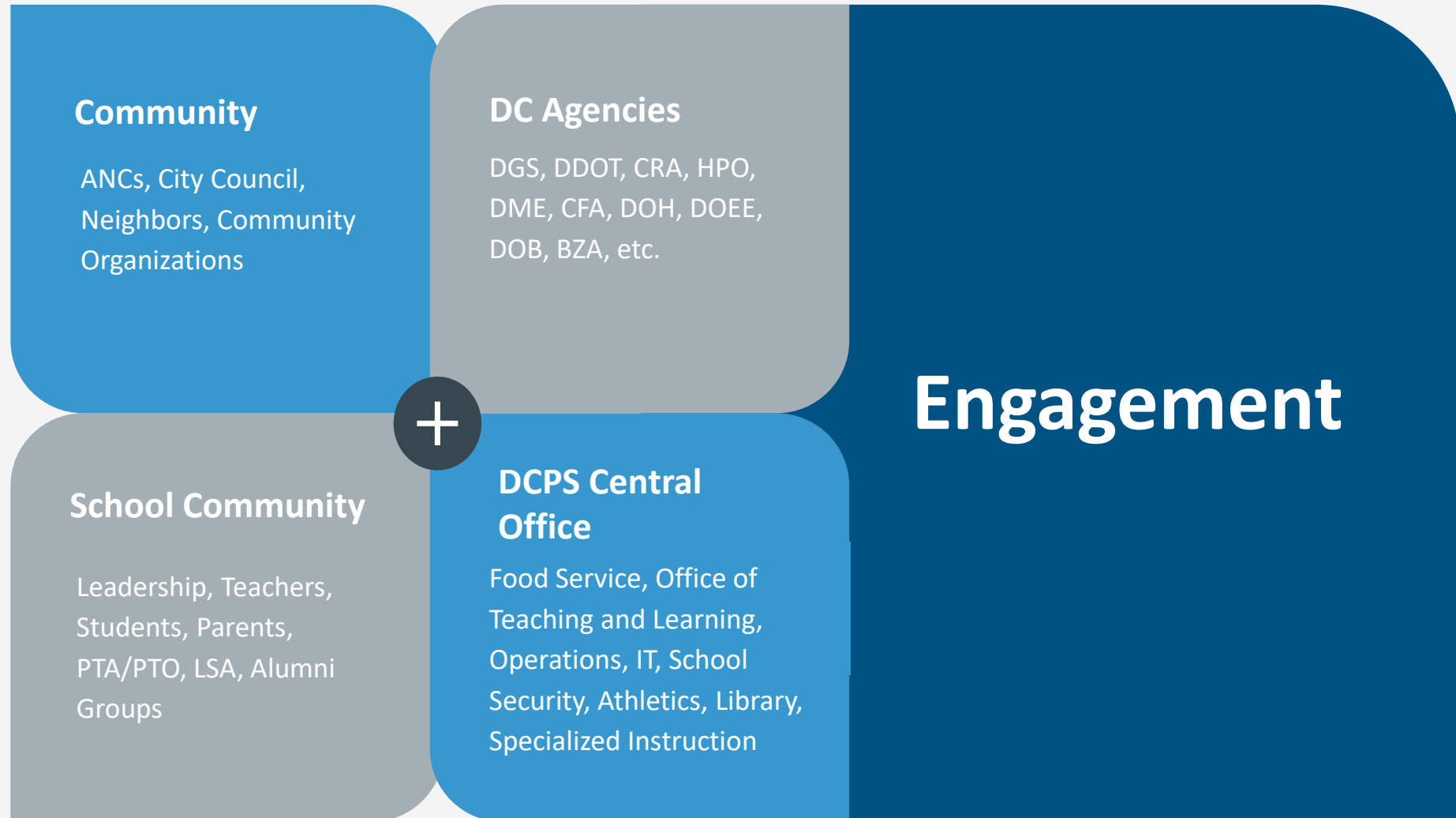

Facilities Engagement Strategies

DCPS' Facilities Planning and Design (FPD) team manages modernization projects.

We engage communities in three main ways:

1. Through the Community Working Group (CWG)
2. Community Meetings
3. Project Updates via Facilities Website

Facilities Engagement through the CWG

The Community Working Group (CWG) is an advisory group for this modernization project composed of parents, community members, and school staff.

We will look to the CWG to:

- Collect feedback and provide insight into the community's perspectives on the design and construction of the new school
- Serve as the link to the broader community by sharing project information and materials

Facilities Engagement through community meetings

The CWG is the primary vehicle for engagement between DCPS, the Department of General Services (DGS) and the school and local communities.

Additionally, DCPS may also host community meetings periodically throughout the project lifecycle.

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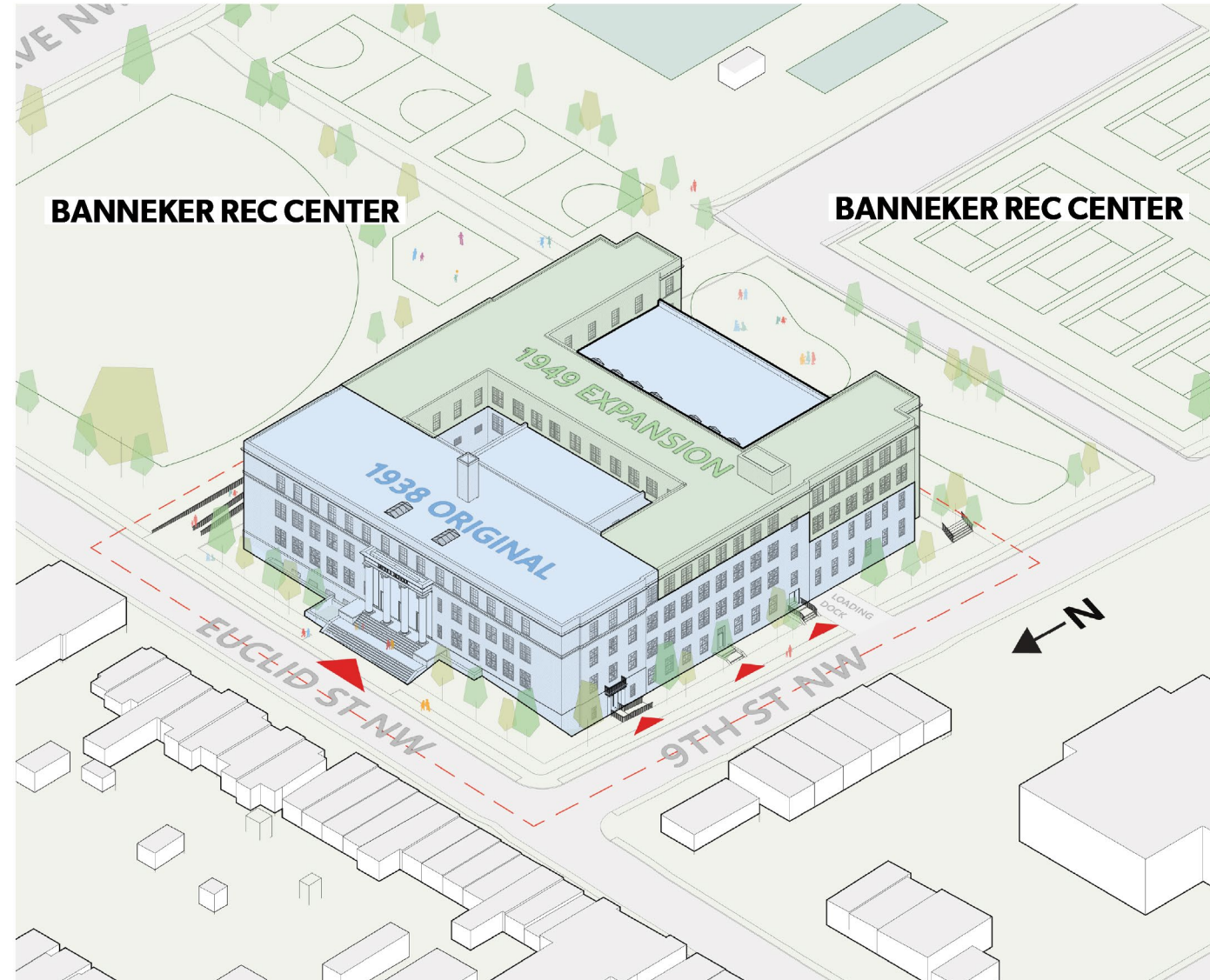
PROJECT SCOPE

- Full renovation & modernization of the building, including all new building systems
- New fixtures, furniture, & finishes
- Maintain historically significant elements of the building
- Room-by-room program per DCPS city-wide Education Specifications
- Net-Zero Energy Ready, LEED Gold for Schools
- Public art program

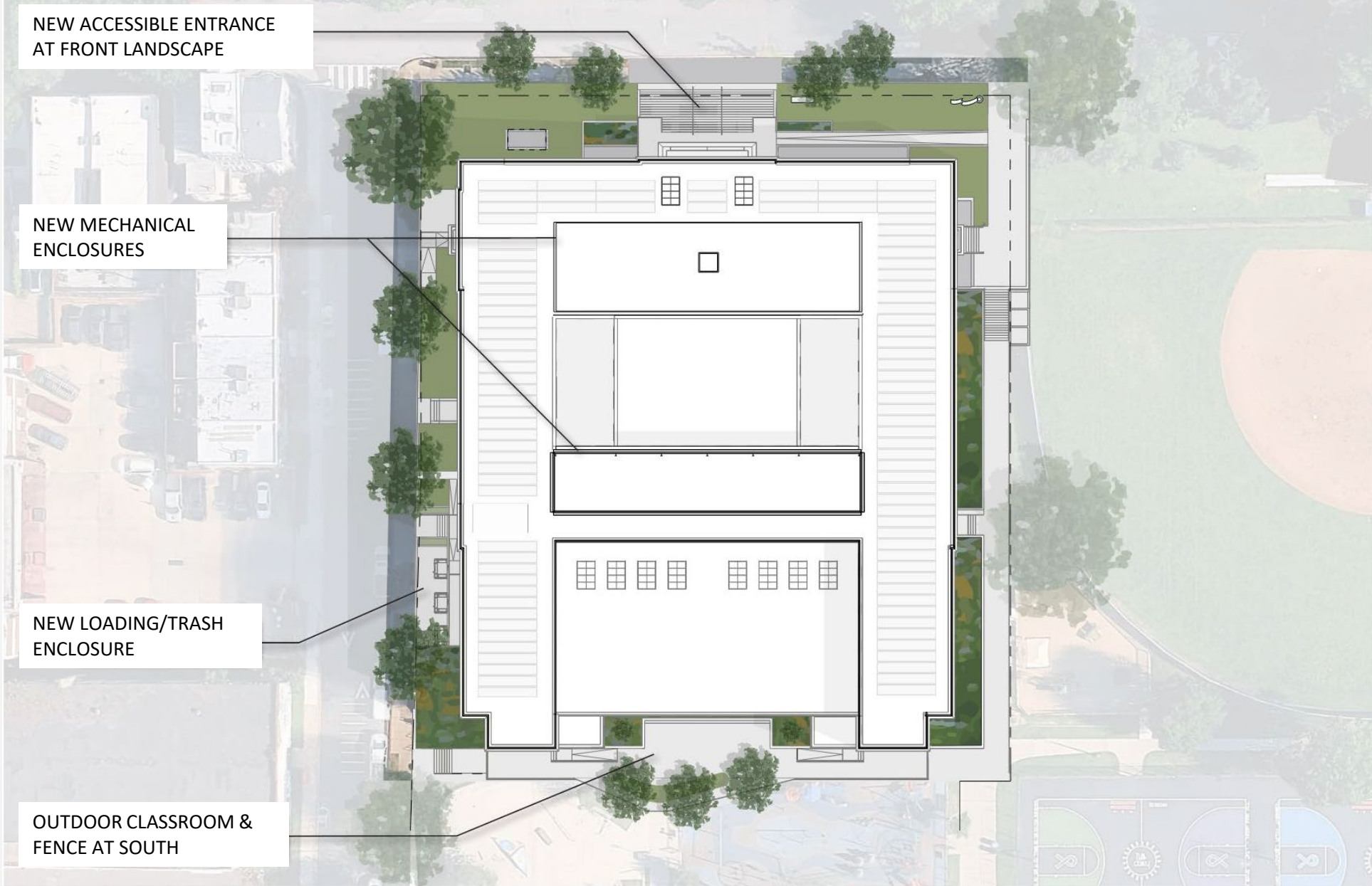
EXISTING BUILDING

- Built in two phases, 1938 & 1949
- Designed by municipal architect Nathan Wyeth
- 141,000 sf
- Currently in use as a swing space for Tubman Elementary
- Existing historic auditorium and gymnasium
- Land locked by street and rec center

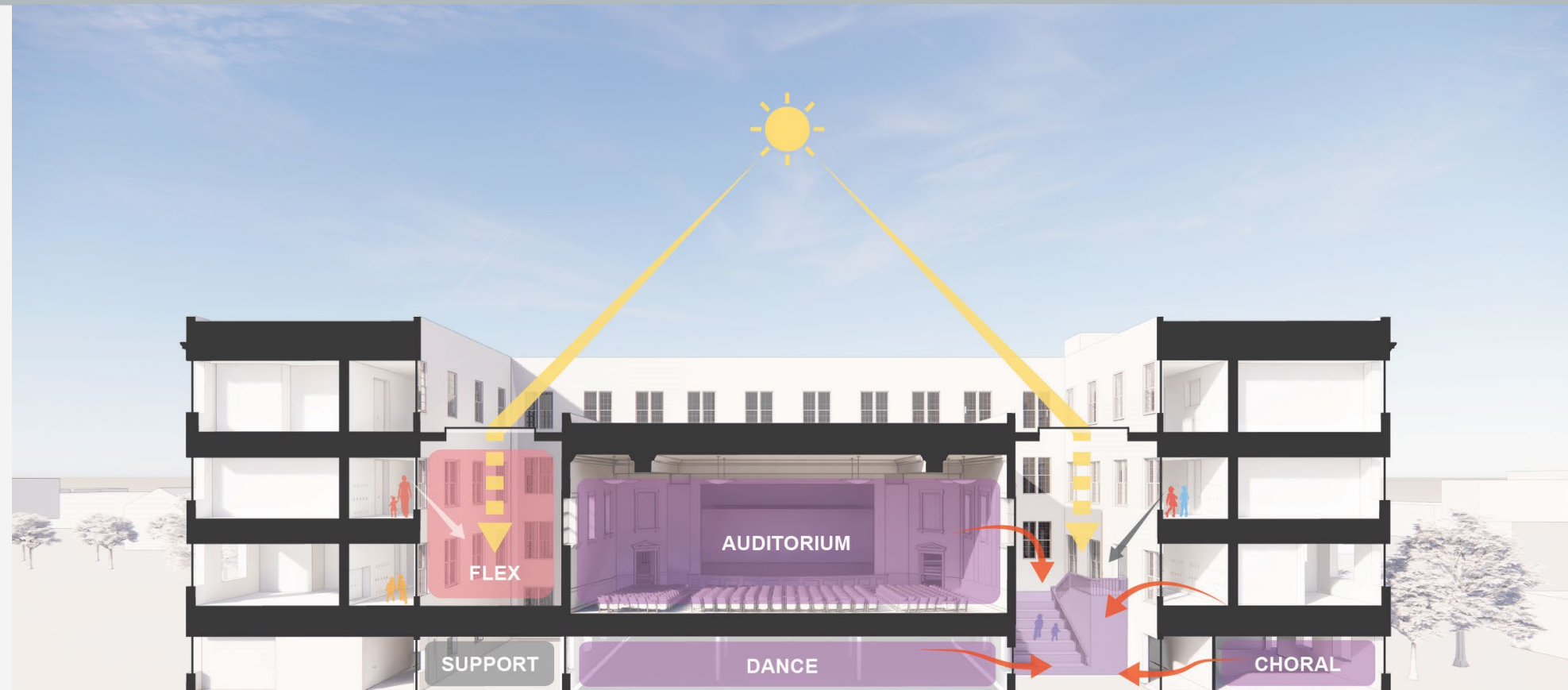
CONCEPT SELECTION & WHAT WE HEARD

- Selection: **Concept 2 & Concept 3 Hybrid**
- Innovation within historic constraints
- Creating a connection between floors
- Maximize usable space - for current occupants and for the future growth of the school
- Maximize the available outdoor space
- Enlarge courtyard window openings to bring in natural light
- Strategic programming of areas with lower natural light access

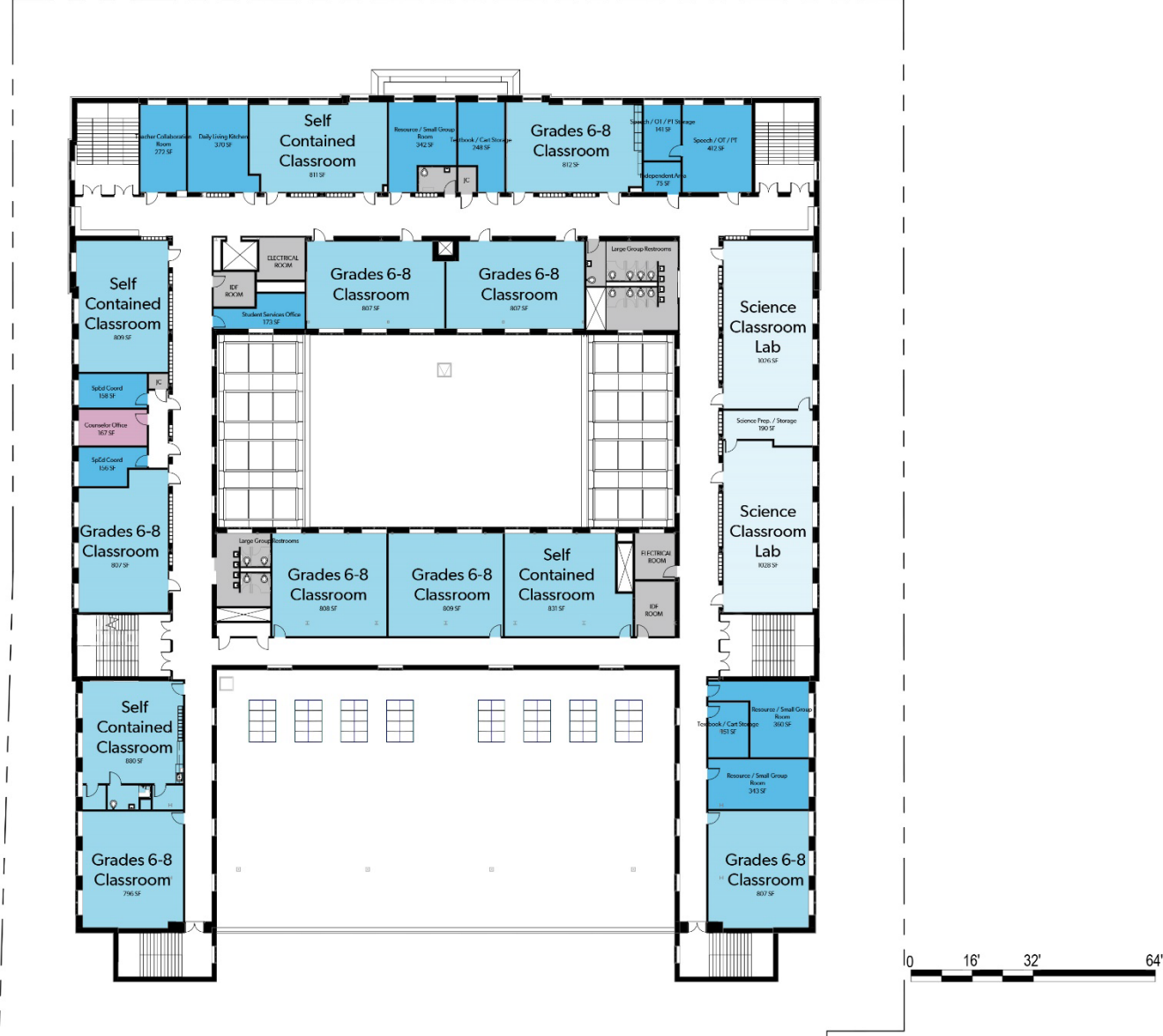


PLAN – LEVEL 2

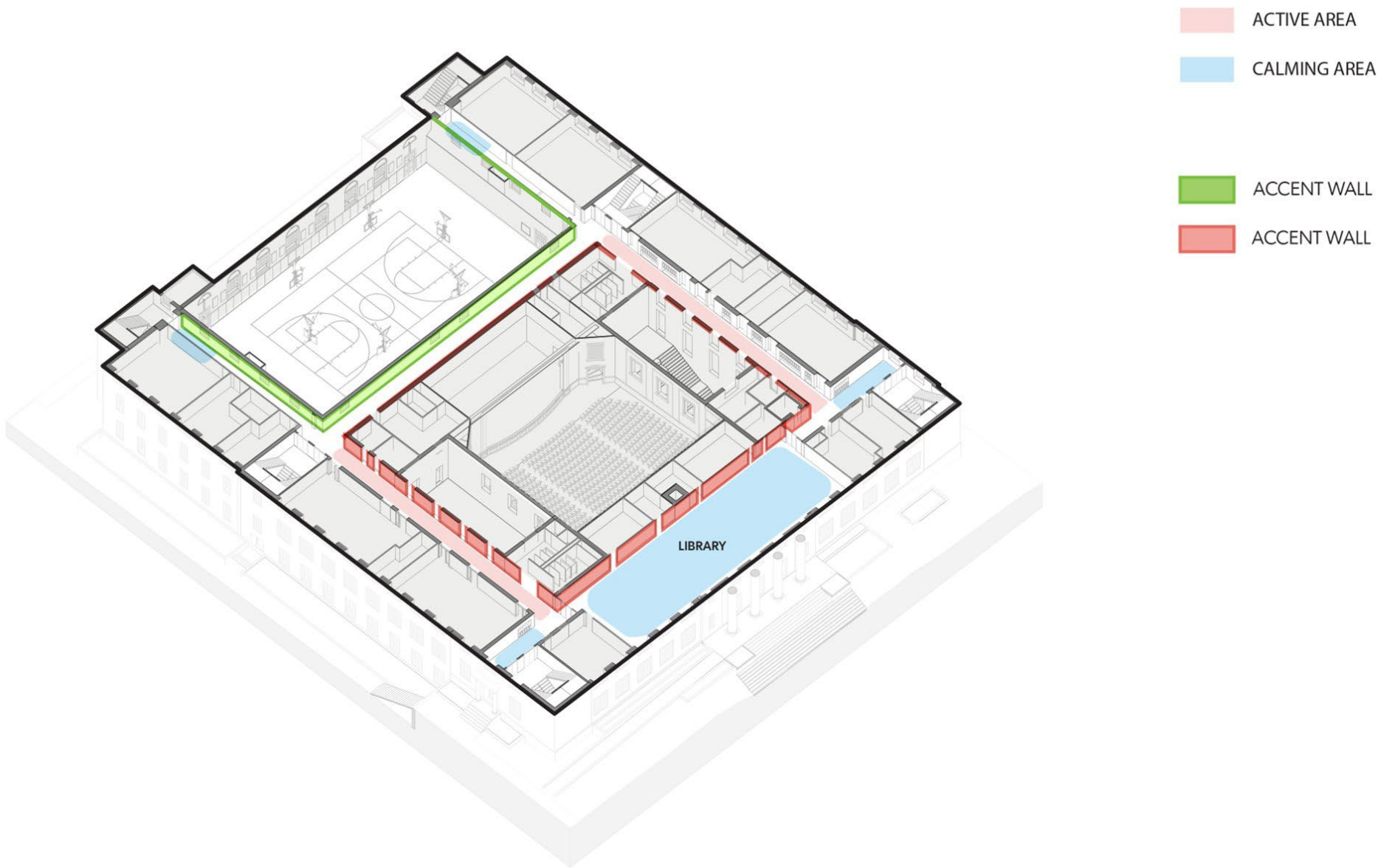

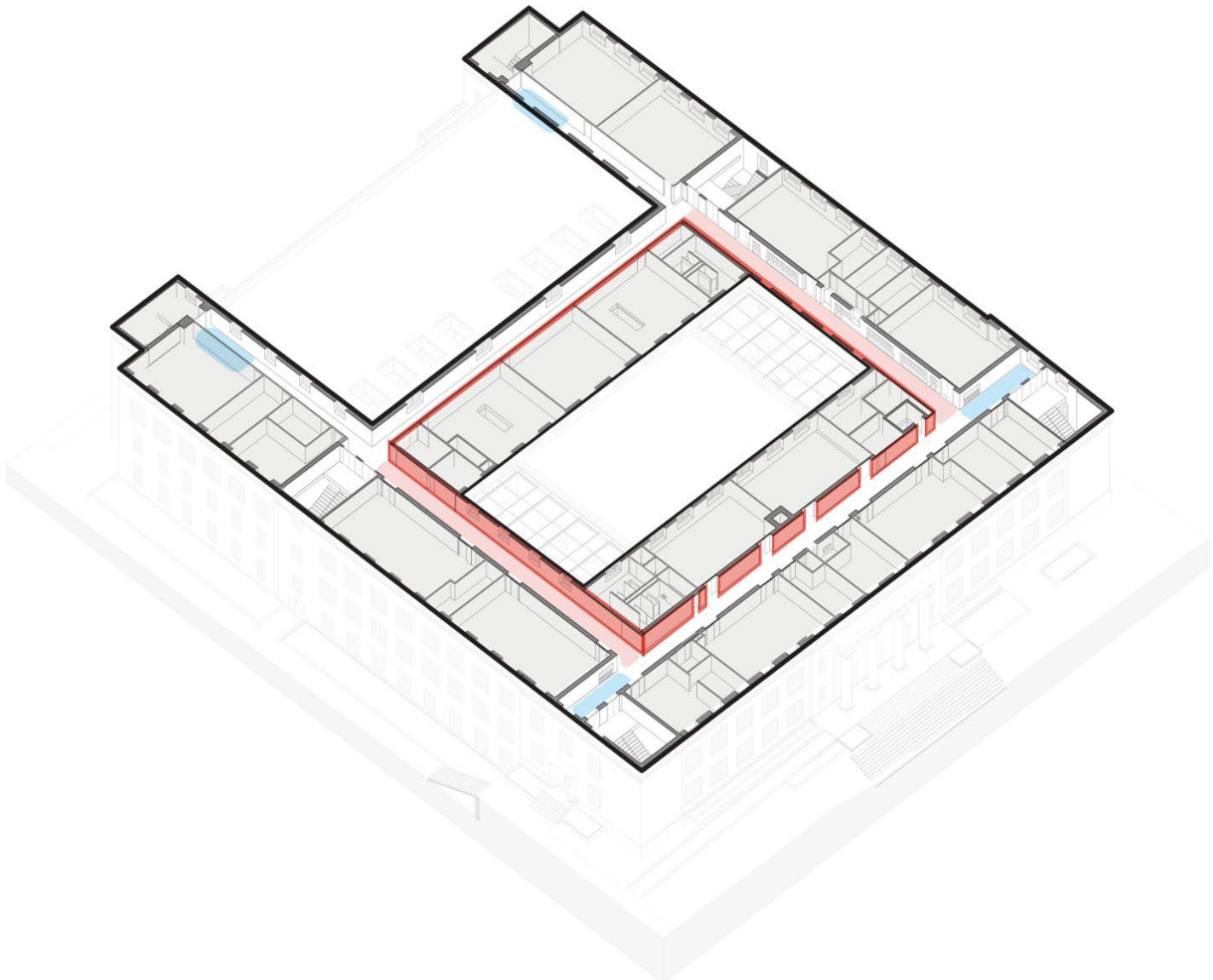
